Faculty in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology contribute to a wide spectrum of educational programs. A six-week core clerkship is taken by all Carver College of Medicine medical students. Sub-internships are offered in high-risk obstetrics (maternal-fetal medicine) and gynecologic oncology. Advanced electives are offered in reproductive endocrinology and infertility, family planning, night float, urogynecology, and various non-clinical and research electives. Approximately 12 physician assistant (PA) students also complete a one-month rotation within the department as part of their training.

The Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) accredited fellowship programs are urogynecology, gynecologic oncology, maternal-fetal medicine (high-risk obstetrics), and reproductive endocrinology and infertility.
