

# Audiology, MS

The MS in audiology is for students currently enrolled in the University of Iowa's AuD Doctor of Audiology program. This degree facilitates the student's ability to apply for temporary audiology licensure if required by the state in which they are completing their 4th year clinical externship. There is no direct admission to the MS in audiology degree program. The doctor of audiology AuD meets all the academic and practicum requirements for clinical certification by the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA) and for licensure by the State of Iowa; the MS in audiology does not.

## Learning Outcomes

Students will:

- be able to accurately identify hearing and balance disorders affecting both children and adults; and
- understand the importance of patient- and family-centered, evidence-based approaches to identify, treat, and prevent hearing and balance disorders affecting individuals of all ages.
