Admission

Applicants for admission to the Geoscience PhD program should have a bachelor's degree in geoscience, earth science, or a related discipline relevant to the field. An MS degree in geoscience, earth science, or a related discipline relevant to the field is not required for admission to the PhD program but is typical of most students and is strongly encouraged. Depending on their prior training, graduate students may be required to take courses that are prerequisites for coursework in their chosen area of graduate study.
