Sport and recreation management majors find employment in major and minor league professional sports; municipal and campus recreation; interscholastic, high school, and college athletics administration; community private clubs and parks and recreation departments; nonprofit organizations; armed forces recreation; amateur and Olympic sport organizations; commercial fitness businesses; and agencies specializing in sport marketing and sponsorship. The sport and recreation management faculty provides individual mentoring to students and offers several opportunities for students to connect with industry professionals throughout the year to learn about internships and jobs.

Experiential learning in the sport and recreation management program in the Department of Health, Sport, and Human Physiology assists students in finding their specific connection to the industry. The Pomerantz Career Center also offers multiple resources to help students find internships and jobs.
