

International Relations, Minor

Requirements

The undergraduate minor in international relations requires a minimum of 15 s.h. in coursework approved for the international relations major, including at least 9 s.h. in courses numbered 3000 or above and at least 12 s.h. taken at the University of Iowa. Students must maintain a cumulative grade-point average of at least 2.00 in all courses for the minor and in all UI courses for the minor. CLAS minors may only be earned concurrent with or subsequent to earning a University of Iowa bachelor's degree. A minor cannot be granted as a standalone credential or as the sole program of study completed at the University of Iowa. Coursework in the minor may not be taken pass/nonpass. Courses graded on a satisfactory/unsatisfactory basis may not count toward minor requirements.

Students may count a maximum of 9 s.h. earned in coursework from one department toward the minor. To view the selection of courses available, see the BA in international relations or the BS in international relations in the catalog.
