

Business Analytics (career), M.S.

Combined Programs

Undergraduate Degree/M.S.

Students working on an undergraduate degree program at the University of Iowa who are interested in earning an M.S. in business analytics may apply to a combined undergraduate degree/M.S. graduate degree program. The Undergraduate to Graduate (U2G) program enables students to begin work on an M.S. degree as they complete their baccalaureate degree. Combined degree programs enable students to earn both degrees in less time than it would take to earn the two degrees separately.

M.S./J.D.

The combined Master of Science in business analytics (career subprogram)/Juris Doctor allows students to pursue two degrees simultaneously, earning both more quickly than they would if the degrees were pursued separately. The Department of Business Analytics collaborates with the College of Law to offer the combined program.

M.S./M.S. in Finance

The combined Master of Science in business analytics (career subprogram)/Master of Science in finance allows students to pursue two degrees simultaneously, earning both more quickly than they would if the degrees were pursued separately.
